1st –8th Grade Faith Formation
Schedule and Overview



Policy:

All 1st – 8th grade Faith Formation student must attend all Family Faith Formation Nights. They are to study their lessons at home, guided by their parents. Students will take a monthly assessment on the material covered for the month.

All assessments must pass with a satisfactory grade of at least 75%. Any assessment rated below 75% will have to be made up and passed.


Requirements:

- Attend Holy Mass and Holy Days of Obligations
- Pass all Assessments
- Attend **ALL** classes
- Participate in Missions (in Advent and Lent)
- Participate in Faith Community Celebrations
- Participate in parish events (*Bless the baby Jesus, Palm Sunday Procession, Crowning of Mary, etc.*)

Structure:

Parent and students meet once a month for Family Faith Formation. (Discipleship) The intention is to instill the Catholic Faith into our hearts through repetition and being able to comprehend more deeply the Catholic Faith and Life. Monthly parent meetings are designed to strengthen you in your role as Catholic parents in communicating the Faith to your children and to be a resource in assisting you. ***REQUIRED... Attendance required for Catholic School & Catholic Homeschool First Communion parents & students**

Remind:

You must be enrolled in REMIND. This is the only way we keep in touch with you. It is a great system that allows us to send text messages to keep you informed! This messaging tool helps us share important updates and reminders with students and parents. If you have not enrolled in remind, please follow the attached instructional form to get you started. Subscribe by text, email or using the REMIND app. If you are not sure if you are enrolled, it will recognize that you have already enrolled and not enroll you again. 

First Communion/Reconciliation Sacramental Requirements:

- ❖ Ensure your family attends Mass every Sunday.
- ❖ Make reception of the sacraments a priority in your family.
- ❖ Practice your Catholic Faith and help your child follow the teachings of the Church in daily life.
- ❖ Two (2 hours Eucharistic Adoration at the Chapel divided in four (4) 30 minute sessions.
- ❖ Attach a copy of child's baptismal certificate with registration.
- ❖ **Non-Catholic School Students:** (*Public, Private, Charter*)
Enroll in 1-8 Faith Formation. Attend class and assessed once a month. Follow all Faith Formation Guidelines.
- ❖ **Catholic School/Catholic Homeschool Students:**
Participate fully in First Confession/Communion Sacramental Preparation Program apart from monthly Faith Formation classes. You are not considered in regular 1-8 Faith Formation. First Communion parents and child are required to attend the three (3) Faith Formation nights: **November 16, December 14, and February 15**

Schedule and Overview



Absences:

All 1-8 Faith Formation students, along with one parent, **must** attend Faith Formation nights. (Both parents are encouraged). Only absences that are emergencies are considered approved excuses. Students who miss **two** classes without an **approved** excuse will require a Pastoral meeting to evaluate their continued participation in the program.

Approved Excuses are those excuses that are due to emergencies and have been reported to the Faith Formation secretary. Funerals or doctors' visits that mandate your attendance are considered emergencies. For **all** absences you must submit written documentation to jody@sprcc.org for it to be considered an **approved excuse**.

Student Absences:

- If your child misses a class, his/her teacher will write their name on the top of the assessment for that month.
- These assessments will be placed in the parish office in a folder with your child's name on it.
- You must schedule for your child to make up the assessment by calling Mrs. Jody at the parish office.
- Testing will be scheduled according to office hours. The child will take the assessment while the parent waits which should not take more than about 15 minutes.
- If there was an activity or craft done during the class your child missed, it will be with the test for your child to complete at home.

Catechism Lesson:

The students study catechism online and their progress is monitored. Online resources provide for a wealth of opportunities to engage in the Faith. There are fun games and interactive learning activities. Parents and students access their study material through the **My Catholic Faith Delivered**. **Students who do not have internet capabilities can request a physical copy of the Catechism book. Please make sure that you have checked off the box on your registration form requesting a text book.*

MCFD (My Catholic Faith Delivered):

All Students that have enrolled in the Faith Formation Program will be signed up for the on-line study program where your child will work on the computer to prepare for their assessment. If you prefer to work directly out of the book, you should have checked the box on your registration form to request that we order the text book for your child. **Fr. Ledoux highly recommends choosing the on-line program since you are given many extras including engaging games, assessments, video prayers, 'Steve Ray Footprints of God' clips, and much more where the content is brought to life for your child.** The following information will be taken from your registration form and sent directly to MCFD to enroll your child in the program.

MCFD will email you with login username and password to get you started in the program. Any issues with technology should be reported to MCFD by emailing the support team at support@mycatholicfaithdelivered.com. They are the only ones that can provide technical support. (Ex. Loss of password, program complications) **Please see attached MCFD handout for instructions to log on to your account.*
