When two of my husband's aunts traveled to the family ancestral home in Ireland, they were taken by surprise at the vague familiarity that seemed to frame every face. In the streets, in the churches, in the shops they felt as though they were flipping through a living family album. This person's smile, that child's eyes, an old man's expression reminded them of aunts, uncles, nieces, nephews, grandchildren, siblings, back in the States. Clearly, they had planted their feet on the very soil where the family had taken root. They felt a sense of belonging to this spot, a sense of completeness and comfort in a land thousands of miles from home. I've never visited the faraway places from which my ancestors came, but I can still relate to Aunt Esther's and Aunt Beverly's experience in Ireland. Whenever I'm in a strange city or even in a foreign country, all I have to do is step into a Catholic Church, and I feel like I'm home again. The flicker of the candle light, the lingering fragrance of incense, the reverent hush, the sight of people silently fingering rosary beads, the familiar faces of well-beloved saints, the blessed assurance of the Real Presence in the tabernacle, the uniformity of the readings and even the colors of the liturgical seasons are all a part of the beautiful heritage Catholics share no matter where we travel. And in that, I find the same sense of comfort and completeness my husband's aunts discovered in Ireland, the same sense of having found what "belonging" really means.
