EUCCHARISTIC ADORATION

Staff in hand

In the gospel, Jesus instructs his apostles to travel light, carrying only a walking stick, the staff universally associated with shepherds. In *A Shepherd Looks at Psalm 23*, author Phillip Keller explains this instrument's significance. When lambs get separated from their mothers, the shepherd reunites them with his staff, and when sheep need individual attention, the shepherd gently pulls them closer by means of the staff. If sheep go astray, the staff is the tender prod that returns them to the right path. Armed with this well-understood symbol, the apostles were sent to form communities of faith called to intimate relationship with Christ and with one another, communities that looked to Christ and His ordained shepherds to guide them on their journey.

2000 years later, a bishop, staff in hand, continues in the apostolic tradition. *Good Shepherd, thank You for the tender provisions You have made for Your flock.* In Adoration we unite love with our Lord and respond to Jesus invitation, "Could you not spend at least one hour with me?" 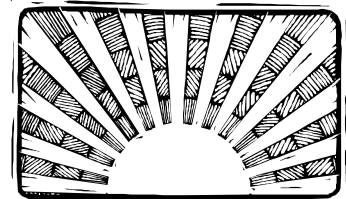
